NEW BUSINESS

<u>Phyllis Thomas Subdivision - Planning Module:</u> Ms. Thomas is subdividing a two-acre parcel on Purdue Mountain. The Sewage Planning Module was reviewed by the Commission, and Mr. Robinson moved to approve the module. Mr. Anthony seconded the motion.

<u>Airport Park Preliminary Plan - Planning Module:</u> The original preliminary plan for airport park expired, and a resubmission of the original plan is now necessary to reactivate the plan; thereby requiring a planning module to be reapproved again for the plan. Mr. Morrell moved to approve the module. Ms. Robine seconded the motion.

<u>Shiloh Road</u>: Mr. Anthony noted the Shiloh Road Steering Committee is looking at possible new zoning classifications at the interchange. The Committee is reviewing the growth boundary issues, and the implications of sewer and water service being expanded into this area. Some townships are raising concerns about revitalization of existing commercial buildings (i.e., Kmart) if a new commercial area is opened up for development around this interchange.

<u>Nittany Valley Regional Comprehensive Plan:</u> The Nittany Valley Regional Comprehensive Plan was adopted by all municipalities (Spring, Benner, Walker, Marion, Bellefonte Borough) in September. A new regional zoning ordinance will be the next undertaking by the municipalities.
