ORDINANCE NO. 67

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AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 25 DULY ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP ON AUGUST 20, 1979, BY AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF AUTHORITY IN SECTION 1.01 OF SAID ORDINANCE AND AMENDING SECTION 2.01 OF SAID ORDINANCE IN ITS ENTIRETY TO PROVIDE FOR REQUIRING CERTAIN OWNERS OF IMPROVED PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THIS TOWNSHIP TO CONNECT TO THE SEWER SYSTEM OWNED AND OPERATED BY SPRING-BENNER-WALKER JOINT AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; DECLARING THAT THE ENACTMENT OF THIS ORDINANCE IS NECESSARY FOR THE PROTECTION, BENEFIT AND PRESERVATION OF THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THIS TOWNSHIP; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

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The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Benner, Centre County, Pennsylvania, enacts and ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1.01 A of Ordinance No. 25 of this Township which reads as follows:

"A. "Authority" shall mean Spring-Benner Joint Authority, a Pennsylvania municipality authority."

shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"A. "Authority" shall mean Spring-Benner-Walker Joint Authority, a Pennsylvania municipality authority."

SECTION 2. Section 2.01 of Ordinance No. 25 of this Township which reads as follows:

"SECTION 2.01. The Owner of any Improved Property which is located in this Township and is accessible to and whose principal building is within one hundred fifty feet of the Sewer System, shall connect such Improved Property therewith, in such manner as this Township and the Authority may require, within sixty days after notice to such Owner from this Township to make such connection, for the purpose of discharge of all Sanitary Sewage and Industrial Wastes from such Improved Property, subject to such limitations and restrictions as shall be established by this Township and the Authority, from time to time."

shall be and hereby is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"SECTION 2.01. The Owner of any Improved Property which is located in this Township and is adjoining and adjacent to the Sewer System shall connect such Improved Property to the Sewer System in such manner as this Township and the Authority may require, within sixty days after notice to such Owner from this Township to make such connection, for the purpose of discharge of all Sanitary Sewage and Industrial Wastes from such Improved Property, subject to such limitations and restrictions as shall be established by this Township and the Authority, from time to time."

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of this Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. It is declared that the enactment of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefit and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this Township.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same expressly are repealed.
