

**Benner Township Supervisors
June 21, 1999**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Benner Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 8:13 p.m. by the Vice Chairman, Richard Lahr with member Helen Alters present. Mr. Kelleher was absent. Also in attendance were Dave Breon, Tom Walker, Renee McGowan and Trooper Montessoro.

EXECUTIVE SESSION NOTICE

It was noted that the Board of Supervisors held an executive session on June 16, 1999 from Noon until 1:20 p.m. on personnel issues.

PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

Trooper Montessoro: Mr. Montessoro was present to report to the Board on behalf of the Pennsylvania State Police. It was noted that increased patrols have been established in the Township. Penn Dot has been contacted to do a traffic study along Segment 310 of Buffalo Run Road to see if the speed limit can be lowered. Officer Montessoro noted that Penn Dot checked their files and only found three accidents were reported along Spring Creek during the years between 1993 and 1998. It was noted that patrols have set in the Spring Creek area but hasn't found it to be very productive.
