# PSU Bus Testing Facility Conditional Use Hearing January 15, 2001

The conditional use hearing for the Penn State Bus Testing Facility was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by the Chairman, Richard Lahr with member Dave Breon present. Also present were Doug Weikel, Helen Alters, Tom Walker, Linn Auman, Connie Houser-McCoy and Renee McGowan.

Mr. Auman was present to go over Penn State's Conditional Use request to construct a 10,000 s.f. building addition and additional driveway to the addition.

No one present had any objections. The hearing was adjourned the time being 7:45 p.m. The Board noted that they will have a decision for the Bus Testing Facility at their February 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

## Benner Township Board of Supervisors January 15, 2001

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Benner Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:46 p.m. by the Chairman, Richard Lahr with member Dave Breon present. Also in attendance were Jon Eich, Doug Weikel, Tom Walker, Helen Alters, Connie Houser – McCoy and Renee McGowan.

## PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE BOARD

<u>Connie Houser – McCoy:</u> Mrs. McCoy was present to discuss deeding an easement to the Township to place a cul-de-sac at the end of Dixon Road. Discussion was held. Mrs. McCoy noted that she would agree to this easement as long as she would still have access to the rest of her property from Seibert Road. It was noted that there should be room for a single driveway but that it may require a large amount of fill to construct it. After further discussion, it was noted that the easement that is currently shown on the drawings might not be large enough to meet Penn Dot's cul-de-sac requirements. Mr. Weikel noted that he would contact Penn Dot to see what their regulations are. Mr. French will also be contacted to see if the deed agreement will need to be modified since Mr. Houser passed away.

<u>Jon Eich:</u> Mr. Eich was present to discuss the proposed new jail site. Questions were asked on steps needed to take place to allow for this use on the site in question. The Board noted that they would need to know the exact area that the county will be receiving. An amendment that would allow for government/governmental uses should work to resolve this problem. Mr. Eich noted that he would keep the Board updated on their progress of the land acquisition.

It was noted that the third annual festival is being planned for the park. Accomplishments this year for the park include the electric and lights being installed, the pavilions being erected and the concrete floor being poured in the one of the pavilions.
