ORDINANCE NO. 136

BENNER TOWNSHIP CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

THIS ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 127, WHICH AMENDED ORDINANCE 43, A JOINT MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEFONTE AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF SPRING, BENNER AND WALKER, SETTING FORTH UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR DIRECT AND INDIRECT CONTRIBUTORS INTO THE WASTE WATER AND TREATMENT SYSTEM OF THE BOROUGH OF BELLEFONTE AS REQUIRED BY STATE AND FEDERAL REGULATIONS.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Benner Township wishes to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents and visitors to the Township and protect the environment;

WHEREAS, sewage effluent from properties within Benner Township are conveyed to the Bellefonte Wastewater Treatment Plant, and are subject to the Bellefonte Wastewater Treatment Plant's Industrial Pretreatment Program which is required to establish limitations on certain materials;

WHEREAS, every five (5) years the Bellefonte Wastewater Treatment Plant, and therefore Benner Township, is required to review and establish "Local Limits" for certain materials:

WHEREAS, the Local Limits are set by the US EPA after their evaluation of the analytical data submitted for the pollutants entering and exiting the Bellefonte Wastewater Treatment Plant for the past five (5) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Benner Township, Centre County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- Section 1. <u>Title</u>. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the Benner Township Pretreatment Local Limits for Industrial Users for 2022..
- Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the provisions of Ordinance 127, adopted on November 2, 2015, which amended Section 4.6 of Ordinance 43, adopted on July 7, 1986. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the Local Limits shall be established as follows:

Local Limits.

A. The following pollutant limits are hereby established to assure blo solids quality and to protect against pass through and interference. No person shall discharge wastewater containing in excess of the following maximum allowable discharge limits.

B. The above limits apply at the point where the wastewater is discharged to the POTW. All concentrations for metallic substance shall be for the "total" metal unless indicated otherwise. The Superintendent may impose mass limitation in addition to, or in place of, the concentration-based limitations set forth herein.

In all other respects, other than as amended herein, the original Ordinance No. 43, as amended by Ordinance No. 127, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after its adoption.
