He reported that the Commission discussed the Comprehensive Plan and Next Steps, Forest Land was discussed, which prompted a discussion on Riparian Buffers, resulting in the County offering to prepare maps for each municipality for their review of Riparian Buffers and where regulations are feasible and where they are not.

The demographics were revised and reviewed again, Mr. Kurtz told the Planning Commission that the County did a great job preparing the data and split the prison population from the general population in Benner Township.

A brief discussion of low income housing was held, which may be an Agenda item for the next meeting, which will be March 20, 2014.

Their plan is to have these facilities close so the residents can just transition from one section to

the other.

Mr. Toretti was not sure if they operate any Assisted Living Facilities or if this one will be the first

time they are putting the two together.

Mr. Swartzell asked Mr. Toretti if he could come up with a percentage of what Graystone would like to

see of their building Assisted Living.

Mr. Toretti agreed to make changes to the Amendment and bring it back to the Planning Commission for

the next meeting.
